
#### What is IPTC?

- Exploring the common ground of technology and management of content in the news industry ...
- ... and making standards if required
  - Metadata schemas + formats for the news exchange
  - Metadata taxonomies for the classification of news
- Global not-for-profit organisation of ~60 members:
  - dpa, APA, keystone (and more) in DACH
  - Reuters, AFP, AP, PA, Xinhua, Kyodo News ...
- Active since 1965




### Building Block: Linking Who applies the linking?

IPTC works on the **Semantic Exchange** project Outline: a system to link vocabularies of news providers to publicly available and free vocabularies - IPTC and more. IPTC aims at finding out more about:

- How easy is it to find corresponding concepts in other vocabularies?
- How much effort does the linking require?
- Is the correctness of the linking/matching widely shared?
- Under what business conditions are vocabularies of news providers shared with customers, ... the public?
- How easily can the linking be used by customers?
